What is Bullying? Bullying means...

...doing one or more of the following:

- **using words** (speaking them or in writing)
- **using physical means** (e.g. kicking, hitting, tripping, and pushing)
- **using gestures**
- **using electronic means** (e.g. Internet, texting)

which:

- Physically or emotionally hurts someone or damages someone's property;
- Makes the person fearful that she/he may be harmed or that damage to his/her property may happen;
- Creates an intimidating, threatening, hostile, or abusive educational environment for the student;
- Does not let someone participate in school activities, excludes;
- Interferes with someone's education, or interferes with how school is run.

Bullying most often occurs as repeated behavior and often is not a single incident between the bullying/ cyber bullying offender(s) and the bullying victim(s).
